Thinktank is not your usual science museum. Its hands-on displays provide a different way of discovering the world, from steam engines to body parts, come and join us in looking at a huge variety of items and artefacts in 10 themed galleries. Not only this but Thinktank also has a state-of-the-art Planetarium (360° visual/audio experience) and IMAX Cinema, the largest screen in the Midlands. The screen is as tall as a five storey building and as wide as 4 buses nose to tail! Prices for the IMAX vary depending on the film. Please ask us on the day for more info.

Once you arrive at Thinktank you can plan your day using the large print maps to get around the galleries and/or visit one of the following:
